

GREEN LIGHT

STUMP REMOVER

**Accelerates The Decomposition
Process For Stumps.**

Size: 16 Ounce

Usage & Application:

Green Light *Stump Remover* may be used to remove unwanted tree stumps by decomposing the wood. After the stump has become porous (through to the roots), it may be easily removed or burned.

Directions: Drill ½" to 1" holes (the length of the drill bit) every 2" to 4" across the top surface of the stump. Along the sides of the stump, drill additional holes every 4" to 6", slanting the holes so they connect to the bottom of the holes drilled from the top (if possible). Fill each hole with ***Stump Remover*** and then add water. Allow four to six months for the decomposition process before removing the stump.

Stumps may be burned by filling the holes of the decomposed stump with kerosene or fuel oil. Wait until the liquid has been fully absorbed by the stump, then apply a slight amount of kerosene over the stump before lighting. Charcoal may also be used around the base or on top of the stump to start the burning.

Green Light *Stump Remover* is economical and will not harm surrounding vegetation.
