Product Description

ProMITE is a selective miticide that provides excellent control of numerous plant feeding mites, while going easy on beneficial insects and predator mites. ProMITE miticide comes in a easy-to-use, water-soluble package for safe, convenient applications.

Pests Controlled

A proven performer with long residual activity, ProMITE miticide provides superior control of phytophagous mites such as two-spotted and spruce spider mites, *Oligonychus* sp., clover mites, southern red mites, and numerous other harmful mite species. ProMITE miticide is labeled for applications in greenhouses and on outdoor ornamentals including nursery stock as well as flowers and plants grown for propagation purposes. It is also labeled for commercial applications to ornamentals in established landscapes such as trees, shrubs, flowering ornamentals, bedding plants, annuals, and perennials.

Suggested Use

For best results, apply ProMITE in a thorough, uniform application when mite populations are just beginning to increase. Without complete coverage, mite control can be poor to unsatisfactory, thus thorough spray coverage is essential. ProMITE is a warm weather miticide that performs best when average daily temperature is above 70° F. Allow 7 to 10 days for ProMITE to demonstrate control.
